The Aspens Pines Water and Sewer District (APWSD) will be replacing its remaining galvanized water infrastructure in the Aspens.

The APWSD has received State and Federal funding to reimburse for a portion of the cost to replace the remainder of the original water lines in the Aspens during the next two years.

Construction will begin this October (2023) and last as long as weather permits. Construction will resume Spring and Fall of 2024.

Each lot in the Aspens has a water service which was installed when the subdivision was first developed. The location of this water service and the difficulty of replacement is unique to each lot based on current landscaping, driveways and home/condominium construction. The APWSD will only be performing work in the road easement portion of each lot, though this might entail close proximity to driveways and landscaped areas. The APWSD will make all attempts to not be disruptive at this time but some disruption is inevitable and we apologize for any inconvenience.

Disruptions could include some or all of the following: road closure, driveway closure, heavy equipment operation and noise, open trenching, periodic water outages and possible EPA required boil advisories for water use.

Individual homeowners directly affected will be notified via e-mail prior to excavations.
